A WELL-KNOWN AUSTIN FAMILY IN CRISIS NEEDS HELP FROM THE COMMUNITY

Austin, TX, August, 2009 -- This is a very sad story of tragedy that's happening to a great family who has helped so many others in the community and now they need a little help. Soul singer and international recording artist, Larry Shannon Hargrove's daughter, Karen Hargrove, Registered Nurse and Medical Assistant, died of a heart attack Saturday (07/18/09). The next day, Sunday (07/19/09) Larry's son, Larry Hargrove, Jr., was transported by air ambulance (Medevac) to Memorial Hermann Hospital in Houston, Texas. His foot had been completely severed and had to be reattached. He has had five surgeries and a skin graft. He has a long and expensive road to recovery. This is compounded by the fact that Larry Sr.'s daughter, Karen (who died) has an 8-month-old daughter named Stormy Tuesday. This baby is now left without a mother. Karen's funeral services were held at St. James Baptist Church, 3417 E Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., Saturday, July 25, 2009. The unexpected expense has put a strain on the family's finances.
